## Beetroot

- leaves and swollen roots are edible
- fertile sandy soil



## Broad bean 'Kings Dwarf'

- heavy yield
- soil enriching plants



## Broccoli

- allow space to grow
- every part is edible



## Cabbage 'Space Saver'

- plant as seedlings
- allow space to grow

### Coriander

- aromatic herb
- free draining soil



### Lettuce

- short harvest time
- rich fertile soil



### Pak choi

- rich fertile soil



### Silver beet

- long productive harvest
- suitable in containers

## Recipe for success:

- Plant in a sunny, sheltered site of your garden
- Work compost into soil before planting
- Apply a general fertiliser to soil and rake it in
- Plant from April. Successive plantings ensure a prolonged harvest
- Protect plants from slugs
