Recipe for success:

- These roses prefer full sun
- · Select a site with free draining soil
- Plant the top of the root ball at the same level as the soil
- · Apply general fertiliser in spring
- Prune roses in winter to remove dead, diseased and distorted growth
- Remove spent blooms to prolong flowering
