## *Archontophoenix purpurea*

- single trunk
- prefers moist site
- height 15-25m

## *Brahea edulis*

- single trunk with large crown
- full sun, tolerates wind
- height 5-15m

## *Chamaedorea woodsoniana*

- single trunk
- sheltered position
- height <5m

## *Chamaerops humilis*

- multiple trunks
- full sun, hardy
- height <5m

These Star Performers are plants of proven excellence in suitable conditions in Auckland. Palms come in a range of sizes and shapes enabling you to choose a suitable plant for most gardens.





### *Dypsis baronii*

- slender clumping palm
- warm sheltered position
- height <5m



### *Hedyscepe canterburyana*

- single trunk
- shady site
- height 5-15m



### Kentia palm

#### *Howea fosteriana*

- single trunk
- shade when young
- height 15m



### Chatham Island form

#### *Nikau Rhopalostylis sapida*

- single trunk
- tolerates sun and wind
- height 5-15m

## Recipe for success:

- Select a site with free draining soil
- Many palms prefer sheltered shady positions when young
- The planting hole should be twice the diameter of the root ball. Plant the top of the root ball at the same level as the soil
- Apply organic mulch after planting
- Apply general fertiliser annually
