- single trunk
- prefers moist site
- height 15-25m



Chamaedorea woodsoniana

- single trunk
- sheltered position
- height <5m

Brahea edulis

- single trunk with large crown
- full sun, tolerates wind
- height 5-15m



Chamaerops humilis

- multiple trunks
- full sun, hardy
- height <5m

Dypsis baronii

- slender clumping palm
- warm sheltered position
- height <5m



Hedyscepe canterburyana

- single trunk
- shady site
- height 5-15m



Kentia palm *Howea fosteriana*

- single trunk
- shade when young
- height 15m



Chatham Island form Nikau *Rhopalostylis* sapida

- single trunk
- tolerates sun and wind
- height 5-15m

Recipe for success:

- Select a site with free draining soil
- Many palms prefer sheltered shady positions when young
- The planting hole should be twice the diameter of the root ball. Plant the top of the root ball at the same level as the soil
- · Apply organic mulch after planting
- Apply general fertiliser annually
