Recipe for success:

- When selecting a tree, check it's healthy and not root bound
- · Recommended planting time is autumn
- The planting hole should be twice the diameter of the root ball. Plant the top of the root ball at the same level as the soil
- Stake young trees at time of planting
- After planting, apply organic mulch
- · Apply general fertiliser annually, especially when young
